I. The Districts created by General Orders, No. 8, are hereby abolished, and the following Districts established with commanding officers as herein designated:

II. First District will comprise the Counties of Mississippi, Crittenden, Desha, Monroe and Phillips, commanded by Col. James T. Watson, head-quarters at Helena, Arkansas.

III. Second District will comprise the Counties of Woodruff, St. Francis, Cross, Poinsett, Craighead and Greene, commanding officer not assigned.

IV. Third District will comprise the Counties of Izard, Fulton, Sharp, Randolph, Lawrence, Jackson and Independence, commanded by Brigadier-General W. A. E. Tisdale, head-quarters unassigned.

V. Fourth District will comprise the Counties of Madison, Carroll, Newton, Boone, Marion, Searey and Van Buren, commanded by Brigadier-General W. H. Fick, head-quarters at Harrison, Boone County, Arkansas.

VI. Fifth District will comprise the Counties of Benton, Washington, Scott, Sebastian and Crawford, commanded by Brigadier-General Thomas J. Hunt, head-quarters Fayetteville, Arkansas.

VII. Sixth District will comprise the Counties of Franklin, Johnson, Pope, Conway, Perry and Yell, commanded by Brigadier-General John N. Sarber, head-quarters at Clarksville.

VIII. Seventh District will comprise the Counties of Hot Spring, Grant, Saline, Prairie, White and Pulaski, commanded by Brigadier-General D. P. Upham, head-quarters at Little Rock, Arkansas.

IX. Eighth District will comprise the Counties of Little River, Sevier, Polk, Montgomery, Pike, Dallas and Clark, commanded by Col. Jo. H. Demby, head-quarters at Mt. Ida, Arkansas.

X. Ninth District will comprise the counties of Calhoun, Union, Columbia, Lafayette, Hempstead and Ouachita, commanded by Brigadier-General Rufus L. Archer, head-quarters at Magnolia Arkansas.

XI. Tenth District will comprise the Counties of Bradley, Ashley, Drew, Chicot, Jefferson and Arkansas, commanded by Brigadier-General Sam. W. Mallory, head-quarters at Pine Bluff, Arkansas.

XII. Until otherwise ordered, Company Commanders will report as heretofore, direct to the Adjutant General at State head-quarters.
