I, JOHN VANLANDINGHAM, WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH: WHILE COMING BACK FROM AN OIL REFINERY NORTH WEST OF TAJI, I WAS IN THE LEAD VEHICLE WHEN OUR PATROL GOT HIT BY AN IED. THE PATROL WAS FROM 3-153 IN AND HAD 6 GUNSHIPS AND 4 OF MY ING VEHICLES. WE WERE HEADING EAST ON A ROAD WHEN AN IED EXPLODED BEHIND MY VEHICLE. THE GUNNER SAID EVERYONE WAS STILL MOVING SO WE SPED UP TO GET OUT OF THE KILL ZONE. WHEN WE REACHED A POINT IN THE ROAD ABOUT 50 METERS FARTHER THE DRIVER SLAMMED ON THE BRAKES BECAUSE HE SAW SOMETHING IN THE ROAD AHEAD. THE DRIVER PUT THE HMMWV IN REVERSE AND WE SLAMMED INTO THE HMMWV BEHIND US AND WAS PUSHING THAT VEHICLE BACK WHEN AN IED 20 FEET TO THE FRONT OF US WENT OFF. AT THAT POINT I COULD HEAR BULLETS HITTING THE HMMWV AND THE DRIVER STARTED DRIVING FORWARD AGAIN. YOU COULDN'T SEE ANYTHING FROM THE SMOKE AND DUST AS WE MOVED THROUGH THE EXPLOSION AREA. WHEN WE MOVED ABOUT 2 HUNDRED METERS DOWN THE ROAD I ASKED IF EVERYONE WAS STILL BACK THERE AND THE GUNNER SAID NO, THAT 2 ING 5 TON LELANDS WERE STILL BACK THERE AT THE EXPLOSION SITE. I THEN TOLD THE SGT WHO WAS THE TC IN MY VEHICLE WE HAD TO GO BACK. WE TURNED AROUND AND 2 GUNSHIPS AND 2 ING VEHICLES PASSED US HEADING EAST. WHEN WE WENT BACK I SAW 1 OF THE ING TRUCKS WAS DISABLED AND THE OTHER HAD ING SOLDIERS IN IT. I THEN SAW ING SOLDIERS LAYING IN THE DITCH. I JUMPED OUT OF MY HMMWV AND RAN TO THE DITCH. I NOTICED WOUNDED ING SOLDIERS IN THE DITCH AND SOME JUST SITTING IN THE DITCH CRYING. I PICKED THE FIRST ING SOLDIER UP BY MYSELF AS HE WAS SMALL AND CARRIED HIM TO THE ING TRUCK STILL IN THE ROAD. I NOTICED 2 GUNSHIPS WITH M2'S FIRING TO THE SOUTH OF THE ROAD AND THE HMMWV I WAS IN WITH A MK19 FIRING TO THE NORTH OF THE ROAD WHERE THE AMBUSH WAS TAKING PLACE. I WENT BACK TO THE DITCH AND SAW ANOTHER SERIOUSLY WOUNDED ING SOLDIER. HE WAS BIGGER AND I TRIED TO MOVE HIM BY MY SELF BUT COULDN'T, I YELLED AT AN ING SOLDIER CLOSE BY TO HELP ME MOVE THE WOUNDED ING SOLDIER. WE PULLED HIM BY HIS VEST OUT OF THE DITCH AND DOWN THE ROAD TO THE ING LELAND. AIF WERE SHOOTING THE DISABLED LELAND AND I RETURNED FIRE AS I MOVED BACK TO THE DITCH, I FOUND ANOTHER WOUNDED SOLDIER AND GOT ANOTHER ING TO HELP ME MOVE THE ING SOLDIER TO THE TRUCK. GOING BACK TO THE DITCH AGAIN I FOUND ANOTHER AND WAS KNEELING DOWN TRYING TO GET THE SOLDEIR TO GET UP AND I NOTICED A BLACK OBJECT COMING THROUGH THE AIR OVER THE REEDS. THE OBJECT WAS A GRENADE AND IT LANDED ABOUT 5 FEET FROM ME DOWN IN THE DITCH IN A TIRE RUT, I DOVE DOWN BY THE WOUNDED ING SOLDIER AND THE GRENADE BLEW. I GOT TO MY KNEE AND RETURNED FIRE INTO THE REEDS. WHEN I WAS FIRING I NOTICED AN ING SOLDIER COME TO MY RIGHT ON THE ROAD AND START FIRING INTO THE REEDS. I THEN LOOKED DOWN THE DITCH AND NOTICED MOST OF THE ING SHOOTING WILDLY AND SOME JUST SITTING ON THE GROUND CRYING OR IN SHOCK OF THE SITUATION. I THEN TURNED BACK TO THE WOUNDED ING AND HE ALL OF THE SUDDEN JUMPED UP ON HIS FEET. IT SURPRISED ME AND I ASKED HIM IF HE COULD WALK AND I HELPED HIM UP THE DITCH AND HE WALKED TO THE LELAND. I NOTICED HEAVY FIRE COMING FROM THE REEDS AS THE LELAND THAT WAS DISABLED BEHIND ME ON THE ROAD WAS TAKING HITS AND THE TIRES WERE BLOWING OUT. I RETURNED FIRE BACK INTO THE REEDS AS I MOVED EAST DOWN THE DITCH. I FOUND ONE MORE ING SOLDIER AND YELLED AGAIN AT AN ING THAT WAS SITTING ON THE GROUND TO HELP ME MOVE THE WOUNDED SOLDEIR TO THE LELAND. WE MOVED THE SOLDIER AND I WENT BACK TO THE DITCH AND FOUND NO MORE WOUNDED TO THE EAST, I THEN YELLED AND MOTIONED FOR THE ING SOLDEIRS SITTING IN THE DITCH TO MOVE TO THE TRUCK. I STARTED FIRING INTO THE REEDS AND STARTED MOVING TO THE WEST TO LOOK FOR WOUNDED ING. I WAS MOVING DOWN THE DITCH TO THE WEST, FIRING INTO THE REEDS, WHEN I FELT THE GAS AND DISCHARGE BLASTS FROM THE ING STILL FIRING INTO THE REEDS, I STOPPED SHORT OF HIS POSITION TELLING HIM TO LIFT HIS FIRES AS I MOVED THROUGH. I THEN CONTINUED WEST FIRING INTO THE REEDS AND FOUND THE MEDIC FROM THE 3-153 UNIT TREATING A WOUNDED ING. I KNEELED DOWN TO ASSIST AND HEARD WHAT SOUNDED LIKE INCOMING AND TOLD THE MEDIC WE HAD TO MOVE. THEN THE MEDIC AND I MOVED THE WOUNDED ING TO THE LELAND. I WENT BACK TO THE DITCH TO MAKE SURE ALL THE ING WERE OUT AND SAW 2 ING DOWN THE DITCH TO THE EAST.

I GOT THEIR ATTENTION AND WAVED THEM TO THE LELAND TRUCK. THEY STARTED MOVING AND I FIRED MORE SHOTS INTO THE REEDS. WHEN EVERYONE WAS IN THE TRUCK I MOVED TO MY HMMWV AND JUST SHUT THE DOOR WHEN I NOTICED 2 ING IN THE BACK OF THE LELAND THAT WAS DISABLED. I WENT TO THE LELAND AND CUT THE STRAP HOLDING THE SIDE RAIL UP AND WHEN THE RAIL FELL DOWN I IMMEDIATELY SAW 1 ING WAS DEAD AND THE OTHER ING WAS MISSING HIS LEG FROM THE KNEE DOWN. AN AMERICAN SOLDIER HELPED ME TAKE THE WOUNDED ING TO THE LELAND, WE THEN WE WENT BACK AND GOT THE DEAD ING SOLDIER AND TOOK HIM TO THE LELAND AS WELL. GOING BACK BY THE DISABLED LELAND I LOOKED QUICK FOR THE ING SOLDIERS MISSING LEG AND FOUND THERE WERE 5 AK47 WEAPONS FROM THE ING IN THE BACK OF THE LELAND. I POLICED ALL THE WEAPONS I COULD SEE AND MOVED TO MY HMMWV. WE THEN PROCEEDED EAST DOWN THE ROAD. WHEN WE HAD TRAVELED ABOUT 200 METERS DOWN THE ROAD THE GUNNER YELLED THAT THE REAR HMMWV WAS BEING ENGAGED. WE MADE OUR WAY TO THE MSR AND THEN BACK TO CASTLE GATE WITH NO MORE INCIDENTS. THE ENTIRE TIME I WAS HELPING THE ING AND RECOVERING WOUNDED FROM THE DITCH WE WERE RECEIVING FIRE BY THE AIF AND RETURNING FIRE WITH M4'S, ING WEAPONS, THE 2 M2'S AND A MK19.

Captain John Vanlandingham

Captain John Vanlandingham distinguished himself through exceptionally meritorious actions while serving as an Iraqi National Guard Advisor on the afternoon of 14 November 2004. That afternoon CPT Vanlandingham's patrol encountered a deliberate ambush set by Anti-Iraqi Forces just off Route Tampa, North of Taji, Iraq. The patrol consisted of US Army soldiers and Iraqi National Guardsmen (ING) traveling in six M114 HMMWVs and four ING vehicles. The ambush was initiated with an Improvised Explosive Device (IED) exploding on an un-armored ING vehicle. A second IED exploded in front of CPT Vanlandingham's vehicle and the entire patrol came under small arms fire. CPT Vanlandingham's vehicle cleared the kill zone and stopped at a rally point two hundred meters away. Upon recognizing that two ING vehicles and several ING soldiers were unaccounted for, CPT Vanlandingham re-entered the kill zone to locate and provide assistance. Once there, he discovered that one truck was disabled and several wounded ING soldiers were taking cover on the road and in a ditch. With disregard to personal safety and under heavy enemy fire, CPT Vanlandingham dismounted his vehicle and attempted to organize the ING soldiers and begin casualty evacuation. With covering fire provided by the escort gun trucks, CPT Vanlandingham began to personally evacuate the wounded soldiers. Still under heavy enemy fire, he repeatedly returned to the center of the ambush and retrieved several wounded soldiers from the side of the road. After gathering what appeared to be all the ING soldiers, CPT Vanlandingham made one last check of the disabled vehicle. There he found one more seriously wounded soldier, one dead soldier, and several weapons. After three more trips into the kill zone, under constant enemy rifle fire and grenade attacks, CPT Vanlandingham personally accounted for all personnel and sensitive items. With this accomplished, he then was able to break contact with the enemy, reorganize his force, and lead the patrol back to Camp Taji for medical treatment of the wounded. Without regard for his own personal safety, CPT Vanlandingham's actions saved the lives of several Iraqi National Guard soldiers. He exhibited both personal courage and competent professionalism in the finest tradition of the U.S. Army.

9. I, Sgt Jason T. Cole, WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:
 On 14 Nov 2004 at approx. 12:30 pm, I, Sgt Cole was the T.C. in D-54. We were escorting the I.N.G. back from an oil refinery on an unimproved road. A couple of clicks from the MSR. A I.E.d was detonated behind my vehicle on the I.N.G. Another I.E.d. was detonated in front of D-53, Sgt Pry's vehicle, Cpt VanLandingham. was a passenger in his vehicle. The second I.E.d. blew approx 10 meters in front of D-53. I had my Gunner, Spc Watkins to engage the insurgents with his 50 cal machine gun. We were receiving a heavy volume of small arms fire. Several I.N.G. were injured or killed in the initial attack. Sgt Pry ordered my truck to follow his to return to the down vehicle. We circled and came back around, there were injured in the ditch. I had my Gunner to engage on the right side of the road where we were receiving fire. I threw a grenade into the berm we were being shot at, I saw a down I.N.G. in the ditch. I sent Cpl Rolak with the C.L.S. bag to give first aid, I then saw Cpt VanLandingham in the ditch trying to drag the injured soldier out. I ran down and grabbed

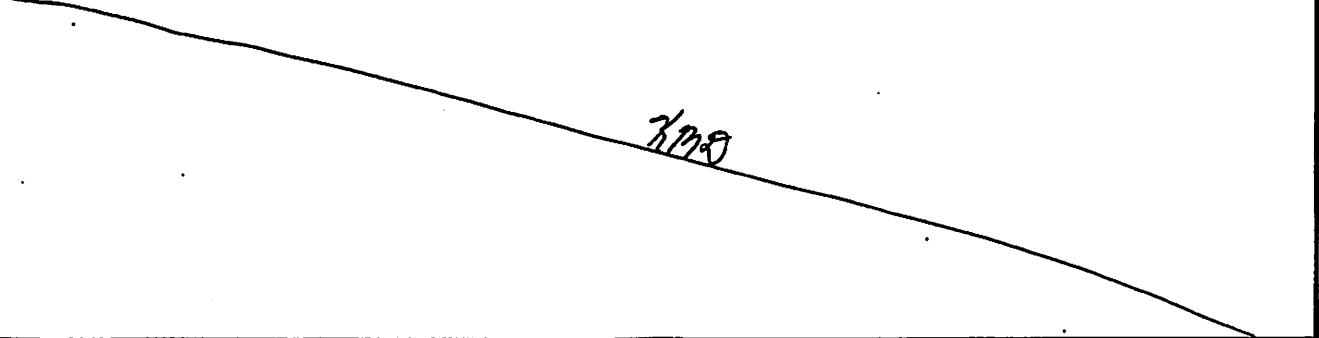

WHILE COMING BACK FROM AN OIL REFINERY NORTH WEST OF TAJI, I WAS IN THE LEAD VEHICLE WHEN OUR PATROL GOT HIT BY AN IED. THE PATROL WAS FROM 3-153 IN AND HAD 6 GUNSHIPS AND 4 OF MY ING VEHICLES. WE WERE HEADING EAST ON A ROAD WHEN AN IED EXPLODED BEHIND MY VEHICLE. THE GUNNER SAID EVERYONE WAS STILL MOVING SO WE SPED UP TO GET OUT OF THE KILL ZONE. WHEN WE REACHED A POINT IN THE ROAD ABOUT 50 METERS FARTHER THE DRIVER SLAMMED ON THE BRAKES BECAUSE HE SAW SOMETHING IN THE ROAD AHEAD. THE DRIVER PUT THE HMMWV IN REVERSE AND WE SLAMMED INTO THE HMMWV BEHIND US AND WAS PUSHING THAT VEHICLE BACK WHEN AN IED 20 FEET TO THE FRONT OF US WENT OFF. 
1. On 1 June 2005, I (Anthony D. Fulton) was appointed as the AR 15-6 Investigation Officer (IO) concerning the circumstances surrounding the ambush on 14 November 2004 North of Taji, Iraq, the actions taken by CPT John Vanlandingham, and the subsequent Silver Star Recommendation.

2. **FACTS:** On November 14, 2005 a platoon from Delta Company 3-153 Battalion was assigned to escort Iraqi National Guard (ING) soldiers to the Oil Refinery North of Camp Taji. Once at the refinery the Oil Ministry officials refused the services of the ING soldiers. On the way back to Camp Taji, the convoy struck IED #1 (See Exhibit K). It blew up somewhere behind SGT Cole's vehicle close to the middle of the convoy. IED #1 injured and ultimately killed several ING soldiers and disabled the vehicle. Shortly thereafter IED #2 went off in front of the lead vehicle which SGT Douglas Pry (the assistant driver) and CPT John Vanlandingham occupied. The gunner in this vehicle reported to SGT Pry that two ING pickup trucks were still at the first IED explosion. SGT Pry then ordered his vehicle and SGT Cole's vehicle to return to the disabled ING vehicles. They circled around the back of the convoy and moved to the ING vehicles where they observed injured ING soldiers in the ditch. SGT Cole ordered his gunner to engage the right side of the road where they were receiving fire. Under covering fire CPT Vanlandingham ran to the ditch and carried an injured ING soldier to the functional ING pickup. CPT Vanlandingham would return to the ditch under fire to retrieve several ING soldiers all the while returning fire. After CPT Vanlandingham retrieved all the wounded from the ditch SGT Pry then gave the order to break contact, but the gunner noticed a couple more ING soldiers in the disabled vehicle. Still under small arms fire CPT Vanlandingham and SGT Cole moved to the disabled vehicle and helped an injured ING soldier whose leg was blown off. They then went back to retrieve the dead body of another ING soldier. CPT Vanlandingham then went back yet again to retrieve the leg of the injured ING soldier and five AK 47s. After double checking for more wounded and weapons the convoy broke contact and moved back to Camp Taji.

3. **FINDINGS:** AR 600-8-2 chapter 3-9b reads: "The Silver Star is awarded to a person who, while serving in any capacity with the U.S. Army, is cited for gallantry in action against an enemy of the United States while engaged in military operations involving conflict with an opposing foreign force or while serving with friendly foreign forces engaged in armed conflict against an opposing armed force in which the United States is not a belligerent party..." So

according to the regulation CPT Vanlandingham is well deserving of the Silver Star recommendation as his actions while under direct enemy fire resulted in the successful rescue of a pinned down ING unit and saved the lives of several Iraqi soldiers.

4. **RECOMMENDATIONS.** I recommend that with the evidence presented CPT Vanlandingham be recommended for the Silver Star Award.

I, Charles L Franks .. WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

5th Platoon received a mission while being OPCON to 1/206th for MSR Security to escort a platoon of ING to a refinery located at MC184242. After being in a large firefight earlier this morning on the route we were to take to the refinery, LT Brewer compiled a couple of battle drills in case the movement came under attack. Linking up with Hawk 6 (CPT Van Landingham) at Hawk Base on Camp Taji, we picked up two extra imbedded trainers to travel in our trucks for additional security. The ING were traveling in two small four door pickups and also in the back of two flat bed trucks mounted with RPK's. 5th headed north on Route Senators to the 30 grid line in 1st ID's area, then turned west on a rough partially paved dirt road to the 19 grid line where we traveled south to the refinery located at the end of Route Redleg. Upon arriving at the facility, the Minister of Oil representative did not want us to leave the ING at the refinery because he did not trust them and said he did not need their help. Also, he stated that every time the ING came to guard the place, it got attacked. After waiting in a security halt for about an hour, we finally got a call from division to bring the ING back to Taji. We proceeded back on the same route as the alternative Route Redleg was totally covered with IED's according to intel. At approximately MC 269312 a large explosion toward the front of our convoy caught all of our attention. I heard an increasing volume of small arms fire punctuated with some medium machine gun fire, then almost instantaneously I saw an IED exploded on the left or north side of the ING troop-hauling truck approximately 100 meters in front of my vehicle. One other ING troop-hauling vehicle was blocking my view of the ING soldiers in the back of that truck. I heard on the radio that the front section of D53, D54, and D56 pushing out of the kill zone with the two remaining small ING trucks like LT Brewer planned in the earlier battle drills. I commanded the first section consisting of my vehicle D52 and D51 to start backing up so we could assess the situation and provide support by fire. Immediately after the IED went off, the soldiers from the unharmed ING truck in front of us dismounted and began shooting in every direction. Most of the ING jumped and rolled into the ditch on the right or south side, while three or four of them assumed a fighting position on the north of the unharmed truck and started firing toward a band of tall reeds close to the canal running parallel with the road and a couple of fortified positions to the north. We began receiving small arms fire and some fire from a medium machine gun at almost the same time. My gunner, SPC C Williams, engaged first with his M4 until it was empty. Then, he opened fire with the MK 19 toward a concrete structure or wall that he saw some people run toward. SGT White, the medic, dismounted and fired with his M4 until it malfunctioned. SPC Jones reloaded the gunners M4, then dismounted and fired with his M4. The first section led by SGT Fry called me and told me that D56 and the two remaining small ING trucks were secure and that they were returning to help get the ING casualties loaded up in the unharmed truck and to assess the damage to the disabled truck. I could see some smoke from something burning toward our northeast, but could not tell exactly what it was. I heard a couple more explosions to the east as the first section came back west toward our position. SGT Fry informed me he had seen an RPG round impact close to the road. I stepped out to see SPC Minniefield engaging some individuals on the north side of the road. SGT McIntyre was laying down a large volume of 50 cal toward the north also. We received some small arms from the south, so I shot a few times at movement in the tall reeds south of us as I tried to get the ING soldiers out of the ditch and back into the good truck. About that time, SGT Fry and his section arrived on the scene. SGT Fry maneuvered his two vehicles to cover the front and side of the disabled vehicle to begin recovery of the injured. SGT Fry guided us to a position forward to provide more firepower and even protection for the recovery team. I received a call from D51 to say he was going to fire an AT-4 at the concrete wall where some of the insurgents were hiding. The AT-4 malfunctioned, so SGT McIntyre switched back to the 50 cal. SPC Jones, my driver, reloaded the gunners M4 one more time, then corrected the malfunction on SGT White's M4 as the firefight was increasing in volume. SPC Williams told me there were some insurgents shooting from a canal ditch approximately 35 meters on the north of the disabled truck. As the site became more secure with our vehicles shielding the injured, I saw SPC Cole, SGT Fry, CPT VanLandingham and the two other imbed trainers dismounted and putting injured ING soldiers on the truck. SGT Fry then moved to the center of the circle to control the movement of the recovery team as they cared for and loaded the casualties. I shot one more magazine toward the reeds on the north side. SGT White was called to stabilize a couple of injured soldiers so they could be loaded. One had a hand severely injured, either by shrapnel or a bullet. Another had several shrapnel or bullet wounds to his extremities. At that time, SPC Williams had shot a box of MK19, so he switched over to his M249 to engage the personnel hiding in the reeds. I saw CPT VanLandingham and SPC Cole load one soldier who was obviously severely injured or possibly KIA. Several were bandaged in numerous places and one had part of his lower leg hanging by a thread. Finally, after two false starts, we got the rest of the ING loaded on the one good truck and started to leave the disabled one behind. SGT White came running and jumped in the truck carrying an ING AK that he found in the ditch while he was operating on

the injured. We started to push up the road a couple of hundred meters and I heard SGT McIntyre say he was throwing a grenade into the weeds as we drove through while also unloading heavily with his M249 like my gunner SPC Williams was doing as we left. Two ING soldiers ran out of the ditch on the south side of the road and jumped in the ING truck as it drove by. As we headed west, the injured ING soldiers were almost flying out of the truck on some of the bunka. The severely hurt one almost fell out one time. Close to Route Senators, we linked back up with the other two ING trucks and D56 (LT Brewer). At an extremely fast speed, we turned south onto Senators which an element of the 1st ID was securing. Three or four ING helmets rolled out of the truck along with some of the equipment and uniforms that the ING were ripping off and throwing out of the back of the truck. At the same time, the ING opened fire into a market on the west side of the road. I never heard any round fired until they opened up on the market. The ING also shot two or three cars driving down the road and were yelling and shooting at everything in sight. The ING trucks pulled into the median to pass our convo, since the lead vehicle could only go 50 mph. The ING left us heading south as we continued toward Taji. I heard LT Brewer coordinating for medical services and more imbedded trainers to show up at Castle Gate to help attend and control the excited ING soldiers. We arrived at Castle Gate and the CLS's from our platoon rushed to aid the injured that were being treated on the ground behind the ING truck. SGT White helped with triage at that time. I saw SPC Basinger treating an ING soldier for a facial injury. SPC Dunn had his bag all spread out and put four or five bandages on one soldier. I saw the soldier with the mostly missing lower leg still laying in the back of the ING truck. Two of the medics carried one of the bloodied ING soldiers to the side and covered him completely, so I ascertained that he was indeed KIA from the injuries received earlier. Four or five of the uninjured ING soldiers were walking around screaming, pulling off their uniforms, slamming down their protective equipment, and then saying "finished." After the injured finally got evacuated the platoon moved to the barracks area for ammo resupply and to prepare to go back out for a couple of hours to finish off shift of MSR Security.
