A couple of requests. Now would be a good time to get the tail numbers (and any other identification you think appropriate) of those UH-60s that were flown in Iraq by deployed members of the 77th. If you would, please send me a copy. I know that someday those aircraft will be replaced and if we have the opportunity to keep one, I'd like it to be one with combat history.

Speaking of combat history; just wanted to recap our previous conversation regarding the UH-1 that was painted with Vietnam era combat markings. I agree that it is a waste of time and money to repaint that aircraft for display at the flag display along with the UH-1M currently there. Your suggestion to prepare the other UH-1 for display along with a AH-1 is agreed to, with the stipulation that the UH-1 with the Vietnam era markings will not be displayed until the other UH-1 is prepared for display.
